INSTRUCTIONS FOR STUDENTS WHO HAVE ATTENDED COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY OUTSIDE OF THE UNITED STATES.

Central Florida Community College is requesting that you have your high school documents, as well as any college or university course work you have completed, evaluated by World Education Services (WES).

CFCC requires a **course-by-course** report to be completed for **all** college course work taken outside of the United States. You may provide WES with your high school transcripts to be evaluated in the same foreign credentials report.
